

Highlights

Sunday: Welcome Aboard | Šolta (On Anchor)

Your journey begins in the peaceful waters off Šolta Island. After settling into your cabin and meeting your fellow travellers, we'll gather for a Captain's Welcome Dinner featuring traditional Croatian dishes and local delicacies.

Monday: Vis Town

Wander through stone streets and soak up the calm of Vis—a favourite among locals for its laid-back pace and preserved authenticity. Known for wine, WWII history, and secret coves, this island is a place to slow down and take it all in.

Tuesday: Hvar

A blend of elegance and energy, Hvar offers hilltop views, ancient architecture, and plenty of sea-swimming spots. We'll dock near the Old Town, giving you time to explore narrow alleys, sip a coffee at a sunlit café, or shop for lavender and local crafts.

Wednesday: Korčula | A Taste of the Land

Today is all about flavour and connection to place. With your host and sommelier guiding the day, you'll:

- Visit a small family-owned farm, where the owners produce their own honey, olive oil, and gin. Learn their story and taste the fruits of their labour under the trees.
- Tour a boutique winery recognised by Decanter, and enjoy a tasting of four award-winning wines alongside homemade bites.

Thursday: Makarska

Back on the mainland, Makarska brings a mix of seaside promenade energy and dramatic mountain backdrops. Grab a gelato, swim at a city beach, or hike the path to the St. Peter Peninsula for panoramic views of the harbour.

Friday: Bol (Brač Island)

Home to Croatia's most iconic beach, Zlatni Rat, Bol also offers charming streets, excellent seafood, and relaxed coastal charm. Swim, explore, and enjoy your final full day of island life.

Saturday: Return Sail | Fumija, Čiovo & Trogir

We'll sail past the quiet coves of Čiovo and Fumija, stopping for a final swim before returning to Trogir in the afternoon. The cruise ends where it began—but you'll come back with new flavours, stories, and friendships.

Onboard Experience

During your week at sea, you'll enjoy a guided wine tasting onboard led by your host, a certified Croatian sommelier. It's a relaxed, informative session that brings new depth to the wines you've tasted along the way.

LIFE ONBOARD

Wake up to a delicious breakfast buffet waiting for you in the dining room. Sit outside and enjoy the glistening Adriatic Sea with a cup of hot coffee. The yacht disembarks from the port early in the morning. Each day, we will stop in a secluded bay to swim, tan, play and enjoy the Adriatic sea. There is plenty of space to lounge in addition to the jacuzzi. If the weather permits and we can go to the local seaside restaurant for lunch, we will use a small boat tender to transport everyone. The boat docks in each city late afternoon, around 3-4 p.m. The exception is Hvar Town and Bol, Brač, where docking starts around 6:30 p.m. Take your time getting ready and mingling with other guests while you decide on a plan for the evening. All mini cruisers are tied next to each other in the port, so you may have to walk across another boat to reach the promenade. You have an onboard Sommelier/Host to guide you throughout your entire trip in Croatia. See the sights, experience the culture, and taste the flavours in every new town we visit.








There are 16 cabins in total: a mix of doubles, twins, and a few with an extra bed option. Lower Deck cabins include doubles and triple options, ranging from 13 to 19.5 m². Main Deck cabins offer both twin and double bed setups, from 12 to 17.3 m².
